

# Candy Holder Instructions

The Candy Holders are made up of 3 pieces, a front, a back, and the bottom made from card stock. The heart shape candies they hold are Palmer Candies. I have found the candies at both Dollar Tree and Family Dollar.

## Materials:

Card Stock

Scissors and/or X-acto knife or Craft knife

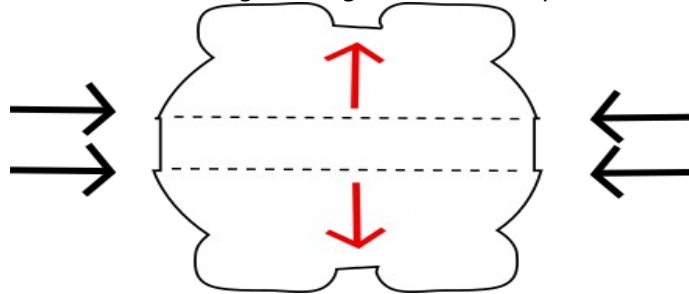
Palmer heart shaped candies.

Fast drying glue

Scotch tape

Cut all three pieces out. You can cut the outside edge with scissors, but it is easier to cut the center heart shape out with an X-acto knife (or craft knife).

The bottom piece is what makes the holder stand up. All bottom pieces have 2 notches on each side to show where you need to make 2 folds. If you are having trouble making the fold, you can run a score line. (Use a straight edge and on a soft surface run the back side of a butter knife along the edge. This will help create a nice clean fold.)



Black arrows indicate where to fold. Red arrows indicate direction to fold.  
The section with the red arrows is where the glue will be applied.

The bottom pieces align with the bottom (feet) of the front and back pieces. Before putting glue on the bottom piece, check to see which side of the fold matches with the back side of the front and back pieces. Once you know which side aligns with the front side, place glue from the fold down and glue to the back side of the front piece. Repeat for the back piece.

Center heart shaped candy over heart. A piece of Scotch tape over the back side helps hold it in place.

Put some glue on the top of the back side (For bunny glue ears and top of head. For gnome glue top part of hat and the heart at the point of the hat.) Line up back with front and push together.
